

#### REGISTRATION

All registration MUST be submitted online through Eventbrite. Attendees may choose to register with their Council/Court as a group or individually.

Timely registration is \$100 per Claver and must be submitted by March 15, 2023.

Registration includes the following: Badge, Bag, Awards Banquet Ticket, Breakfast Ticket, Digital Souvenir Book, access to the Health Fair, and access to fitness activities.

Late registration will run from March 16, 2023 through April 7, 2023 at \$125 per Claver. Barring extenuating circumstances, to be determined by the Joint Texas State Conference Board, any registration payments postmarked after April 7, 2023 will be returned and registration will not be processed.

### PAYMENT METHODS


